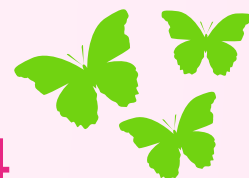

Here's a few of our big events we contributed to the last three years...

- In 2023, Nana's Tatas NFP hosted a fundraiser to raise funds for LUCERO (Latinos United for Cancer Education, Research and Outreach): This group works with communities in Chicago and surrounding areas to improve cancer screenings and health outcomes for Latinos.
- In 2024, Nana's Tatas NFP hosted a Sneaker Masquerade Ball fundraiser to raise funds for Lurie Cancer Center Hispanic Breast Cancer Clinic at Northwestern Memorial Hospital with Dr. Tellez
- In 2025, Nana's Tatas NFP participated & donated to ELLAS an initiative of The Resurrection Project whose mission is to create a safe space for Latina women. We was able to donate 25 chemo care packages filled with donated items: mints, tea, lotions, chapsticks, books, socks, hats, mouthwash, coloring pencils, crayons, NT t-shirts and a monetary donation.
